


# Lancaster is one of the largest Republican Counties, and the largest that has a Republican majority.






### Republicans registrations have been increasing, but not as fast as the county.








### Republican Registrations have grown the slowest. We have to work together!





### Republican Registrations are losing share to Democrats and Independents.




### Total % of Registered Voters Lancaster County, by Party


Lancaster City is a cautionary tale. The City was recently majority Republican, and now it is among the smallest number of Republicans.

# Today, we have 345,598 registered voters in Lancaster County, of whom, 51% are Republican.







Registered Voters in Lancaster County by Party and Frequency of Voting




# In 2023, turnout was 124k, larger than expected, but only 36% of total registered voters




Registered Voters in Lancaster County, by Turnout and Party


% of Registered Voters, by Party, Who Turned Out for the Election




### Registered Voters in Lancaster County, by Turnout, Party and Voting Mode




### The oldest demographic is an important voting block in Lancaster

Registered Voters in Lancaster County, by Age





## The return rate for Mail-In Ballots are high! Those who request a mail-in ballot return it.




## In 2020 we had turnout of 253,403 voters, 55% of whom are Republican



Number of Electoral College Votes for the Winning Presidential Candidate, by Party in PENNSYLVANIA




### Total Registered Voters in Lancaster County, by Area and Turnout




### Registered Voters in Lancaster County, by Age and Those Requesting a Mail-In Ballot






- Being on committee is an honor and responsibility. Every committee seat has to be won in May, so challengers are welcome.






